The certificate can be taken in connection with a geography or other degree, or as a stand-alone certificate.

Grading Requirement

All courses taken to fulfill program course requirements must be taken for a letter grade except those courses specified by the department as credit/no credit grading only.

A grade point average of 2.5 must be earned for courses required for the certificate. A grade of C or higher must be earned in each course required of the certificate program.
