## Grading Requirement

A grade-point average of 3.0 must be earned for courses required for the post-baccalaureate certificate program with a B- or higher earned in each course. A maximum of 9 units required for the certificate may be applied to the MBA.

At least 9 units must be at the 600 level. A maximum of 3 units of transfer credit may be allowed.
