- A minimum of two years at a music department, school of music, or conservatory with a music major/voice emphasis, and a minimum GPA of 2.5;
- 2. A taped audition;
- 3. Application letter and resume;
- A minimum of three letters of reference from voice/music faculty or private instructors;
- 5. Basic piano skills (minimum of three years of study);

- Internet or direct phone interview with California State University, Chico voice faculty;
- 7. International students must have a minimum TOEFL score of 400.
