You will examine the ethical complexities involved in balancing the needs and desires of humans in community and develop strategies to reimagine a more equitable world.

Students who are already completing the associated General Education Equity, Ethics, and Policy upper-division Pathway can earn the minor by taking six courses from different GE Areas. Students who complete all courses in the minor will meet the University's U.S. Diversity (USD) and Global Cultures (GC) requirements, as well as at least one upper-division Writing (W) course.
