INST 110 Introduction to International Engagement 3 Units GE, USD

Typically Offered: Fall and spring

The nature of study, work, volunteering, and travel abroad. Emphasis on an exploration of the self as an integrated physiological, social, and psychological being while living abroad. Students learn to differentiate between personal, cultural, and universal patterns in order to develop greater understanding of themselves and people of other cultures. 3 hours lecture. (021206)

INST 110W Introduction to International Engagement (W) 3 Units GE, USD, W

INST 398 Special Topics 1-3 Units
