## INTB 198 Special Topics 1-3 Units

**Prerequisite:** Department permission.

**Typically Offered:** Fall and spring

This course is for special topics. Typically the topic is offered on a one-time-only basis and may vary from term to term and be different for different sections. See the Class Schedule for the specific topic being offered. 3 hours supervision. (004924)

**Grade Basis:** Graded

**Repeatability:** You may take this course more than once

**Course Attributes:** Lower Division

## INTB 389 Intern/Cooperative Education 1-3 Units

**Prerequisite:** Senior standing, faculty permission.

**Typically Offered:** Inquire at department

This course is an internship. You must register directly with a supervising faculty member. For students who wish to gain practical work experience with participating firms/organizations. This course enables a student to study policy, control, and decision-making in a specialized work environment. See advisor for student's performance requirements, assignments, and methods of evaluation prior to undertaking the internship. 9 hours supervision. (004925)

**Grade Basis:** Credit/No Credit

**Repeatability:** You may take this course for a maximum of 15 units

**Course Attributes:** Upper Division

## INTB 399 Special Problems 1-3 Units

**Typically Offered:** Inquire at department

This course is an independent study of special problems. You must register directly with a supervising faculty member. Students registering for this course should prepare a project proposal to be discussed with their faculty advisor before enrolling in the course. 9 hours supervision. (001062)

**Grade Basis:** Credit/No Credit

**Repeatability:** You may take this course for a maximum of 6 units

**Course Attributes:** Upper Division

## INTB 498 Special Topic in International Business 1-3 Units

**Prerequisite:** Senior standing.

**Typically Offered:** Inquire at department

This course is for special topics. Typically the topic is offered on a one-time-only basis and may vary from term to term and be different for different sections. See The Class Schedule for the specific topic being offered. For advanced students who wish to investigate business problems in specialized areas. Application of research methods. 3 hours supervision. (004928)

**Grade Basis:** Graded

**Repeatability:** You may take this course more than once

## INTB 499 Special Problems 1-3 Units

**Prerequisite:** Faculty permission.

**Typically Offered:** Inquire at department

**Repeatability:** You may take this course for a maximum of 6 units

## INTB 697 Independent Study 1-3 Units
